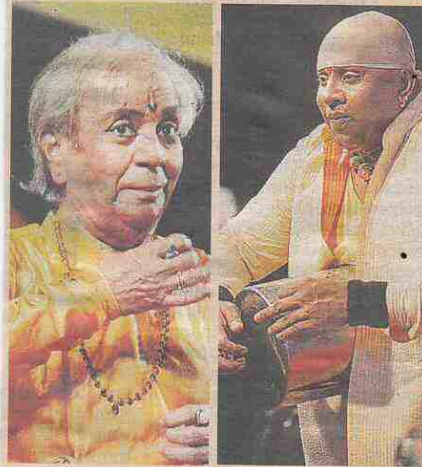


A RARE JUGALBANDI IN ASSOCIATION WITH t2
